of Sparks, County of Washoe, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Chalk Hills Spring Name of stream, lake, or other source
2. The amount of water applied for is Two second-feet. One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches
3. The water to be used for Stock Watering and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Section 36, T. 17 N., R. 21 E., M. D. B. & M. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.

(g) State number and kinds of animals to be watered 4,000 head of sheep
(h) Use will begin about Jan 1 and end about Dec. 31, of each year. Month Month
(i) Remarks Water will be used to water sheep during the annual grazing season; Domestic use will be year around.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

No works of diversion are at present required. The animals drink directly out of the spring. Spring has been improved by means of a tunnel to increase flow of spring.
