Drilled well 8" casing, 5 HP Turbine pump, 1000 gallon pressure tank and miscellaneous size pipes to points of use.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights and is further subject to revocation when water is available from the Las Vegas Valley Water District, and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 0.03 c.f.s. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to Sec. 4 of the 1939 Ground-Water Act (Chap. 178, Stats. 1939 as amended); therefore the State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 18, 1956

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 18, 1956

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 18, 1957

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 18, 1957

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 18, 1958

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before August 18, 1958
