

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The undersigned A. L. ARNOLD (Four Seasons Trailer Park & Sales)
of Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an underground source within the Las Vegas Artesian Basin, Clark County, Nevada, (Vicinity of North Las Vegas)

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.20 second-feet.

3. The water to be used for Commercial (trailer park & sales)

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: Within SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 7, T. 20 S, R 62 E, MD.M. or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 7 bears South 39° 04' West a distance of 1248 feet.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

(b) Description of land to be irrigated

- (h) Use will begin about Jan. 1st and end about Dec. 31st, of each year.

(i) Remarks This well was drilled and completed July 30, 1955 for domestic use. Since then it was decided to file and appropriate water under commercial use, and said water will commingle with the developed water from a proposed Well being filed by same applicant and owner, situate within NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 7, T. 20 S, R 62 E. (See reverse side for potential use and development of the property.)

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Water to be diverted from a 12" drilled and 8" cased Well and distributed thru State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water a 4" main pipe line to commingle with the appropriated water of a proposed Well is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions. situate within NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 7, T 20 S, R 62 E and 1" services to various places of use within the designated area. A 5 HP pump will be installed to develop water and a 5000 gal. tank for pressure purposes, together with the necessary gates and valves for control purposes.

5. Estimated cost of works \$10,000

6. Estimated time required to construct works one (1) year

7. Remarks The 4.7 acre area will be improved with various buildings for trailer sales (office, service etc). The appropriated water from this well will commingle with the appropriated water from a Well to serve a trailer park to accommodate approx. 300 stalls (each will be serviced with water, Power, and sewer facilities).

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights and is further subject to revocation when water is available from the Las Vegas Valley Water District, and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 0.10 c.f.s. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to Section 4 of the 1939 Ground-Water Act (Chap. 178, Stats. 1939 as amended); therefore the State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 3, 1957

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before May 3, 1957

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 3, 1958

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before May 3, 1958

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 3, 1959. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before May 3, 1959
