(i) Remarks: Ultimately enough water will be required to supply 19 motel units, one residence, one coffee shop and 100 trailers. A total of 121 units. There is space for still more trailer units.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS.

Upon completion of well, a motor driven pump and tank of adequate State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water capacity will be installed. (Pump will probably be large enough to meet a demand load of 150 to 200 gallons per minute). The necessary pipe lines to conduct the water to the points of use will be installed when a plan of the Trailer Camp is drawn.

- 5. Estimated cost of works \$3,000 to \$5,000
6. Estimated time required to construct works 60 to 90 days. (May not be entirely completed for 6 months to a year).
7. Remarks This well will supplement the present existing well which probably will be inadequate. This well should be able to serve the whole area should more units be added over and above what is now planned.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights and is further subject to revocation when water is available from the Las Vegas Valley Water District, and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 0.10 c.f.s. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to Section 4 of the 1939 Ground-water Act (Chap. 178, Stats. 1939 as amended); therefore the State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 5, 1956

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before October 5, 1956

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 5, 1957

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before October 5, 1957

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before September 5, 1958

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before October 5, 1958
