DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Cleaned spring head and enclosed spring with fence, installed 30' of 2" pipe from spring head to outside of fence. Water runs easterly 250 feet to a series of three catch basins. A 2d water source, S. 42° E., 270 feet also runs NE about 150 feet to the same catch basins. The .033 cfs in item 2 is the total water flowing into the catch basins.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 0.033 cubic foot of water per second herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.033 cubic feet per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 7, 1956.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before January 7, 1957.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 7, 1957.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before January 7, 1958.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before December 7, 1958.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before January 7, 1959.
