

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The undersigned F. E. Walthall
of Bakersfield, County of Kern, State of California, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground
2. The amount of water applied for is three second-feet.
3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic
4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 32, T. 19 S., R. 53 E., MDM., whence the NE Cor. of said Sec. 32 bears N. 45 E., 100 feet.

IF THE WATER IS TO BE USED FOR IRRIGATION, SUPPLY THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (a) Number of acres to be irrigated is 320
(b) Description of land to be irrigated N 1/2 Sec. 32, T. 19 S., R. 53 E.

- (c) Use will begin about Jan. 1st and end about Dec. 31st of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 3.0 c.f.s. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittees well due to other ground water development in the area. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to Section 4 of the 1939 Ground-Water Act (Chap. 178, Stats. 1939 as amended); therefore the State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.0

cubic feet per second, or a yearly duty of 5 acre feet per acre of land irrigated.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 18, 1956

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before December 18, 1956

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 18, 1957

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 18, 1957

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 18, 1961. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before December 18, 1961
