DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Aditch 8' wide on top and 2' deep on a grade of 0.1% will convey the State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water waters of Upper Steptoe Creek into the Cave Lake Reservoir-which is is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions. located in the S $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 5, and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 8, T. 15 N., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit to divert and store 8.0 c.f.s. in a reservoir of undetermined capacity in acre-feet for irrigation on 2,300 acres of land is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. The proof of beneficial use and cultural map when filed must show the maximum amount of water stored and released during any one year, and the lands on which such water was used. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 8.0 cubic feet per second, duty of water from all sources not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre irrigated.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 1, 1960

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 1, 1960

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1962

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 1, 1962

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

June 1, 1964. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before July 1, 1964
