hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) Name of stream, lake, or other source

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.03 second-feet. One second-foot equals 40 miners' inches

3. The water to be used for Commercial (Trailer Court) and Domestic. Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use

4. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: A parcel in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 20, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, or by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated. at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 20 bears S. 20° 24' 40" W. a distance of 546.7 Feet.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

A5 HP. electric motor and corresponding pump is to be installed along State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits. If water with a 1,000 gallon capacity tank for storage. The system of pipes is to be stored in reservoirs, it should be so stated and the location of the reservoir should be given with reference to the legal subdivisions. serving the various units will be 2" and decrease as necessary down to 3/4" diameter.

5. Estimated cost of works \$1,500 to \$2,500. (As yet contract has not been let for the motor, pump and tank.)

6. Estimated time required to construct works 60 to 90 days

7. Remarks Ultimately there will be from 44 to 48 units (trailer spaces) using water, besides an office, residence (part of office building), utility room (laundry, shower baths, rest rooms, etc.), and swimming pool.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to existing rights and is further subject to revocation when water is available from the Las Vegas Valley Water District, and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to Section 4 of the 1939 Ground-Water Act (Chap. 178, Stats. 1939 as amended); therefore the State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 27, 1957

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before April 27, 1957

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 27, 1958

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before April 27, 1958

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before

March 27, 1959. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before April 27, 1959
