APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the number of stock watered daily, which number must be stated in the proof of beneficial use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0156 cubic feet per second, or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 30, 1957

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 30, 1957

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 30, 1958

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 30, 1958

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 30, 1958. Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before August 30, 1958

Applicant is the owner of the Bartlett Creek Ranch, the Battle Creek Ranch and the Piute Creek Ranch in western Humboldt County, Nevada. Since prior to the year 1867 applicant and its predecessors in interest have used said ranches and the public range in the adjacent area and all water sources on said ranches and such public range for feeding and watering livestock including horses, cattle and sheep. Said ranches, such public range, and such water sources were so used for sufficient numbers of such livestock to utilize substantially all that portion of the public range readily available to livestock at all such water sources. The number, and kind of livestock, has varied, and will vary with range and economic conditions. The applicant claims a vested right to water livestock at the source referred to in this application in sufficient numbers to utilize substantially all that portion of the public range readily available to livestock watering at such source. The filing of this application is for the purpose of making such rights of record and does not waive applicant's claim of such vested right.
