The undersigned U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service, Bureau of Sport Fisheries and Wildlife of Portland, County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.)

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORKS

Cleaned out three spring heads and diverted three flows into one.

Fenced in source for protection. Water flows southerly 40 feet to a 30' diameter earth catch basin.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 0.007 cubic-foot of water per second herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.007 cubic foot per second.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 6, 1959.

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before March 6, 1959.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 6, 1960.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 6, 1960.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 6, 1960.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use must be filed with State Engineer on or before March 6, 1960.
