APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights and with the understanding that any part of the right granted which is made in part of discharged waters by the Clark County, Nevada Sewage Disposal Plant as shown by the accompanying map does not constitute a permanent right and does not in any manner obligate the Clark County Plant to continue the abandonment of water as it now exists. A substantial headgate and measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.7 cubic feet per second, or a yearly duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 26, 1964

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before March 26, 1964

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 26, 1965

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 26, 1965

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 26, 1967. Proof of the application of water to beneficial

use must be filed with State Engineer on or before March 26, 1967
