State of California, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Bodie Creek
Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 3.0 second-feet.
One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.
(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Irrigation

6. Place of use NW 1/4 of NE 1/4 and NE 1/4 NW 1/4 said Sec. 24, T. 6 N., R. 27 E., M.D.M.

7. Use will begin about Jan. 1 and end about Dec. 31, of each year.
