APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 4.0 cubic feet per second, herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued subject to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in the Seventh District Court of the State of Nevada in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights in and to the Waters of Bassett Creek and its Tributaries in White Pine County, Nevada.

This Permit is issued subject to State Engineer's Ruling #6194, and is limited to 4.0 cubic feet per second of flood or excess water for the irrigation of 400 acres between March 15th and July 1st of each year.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 4.0 cubic feet per second for the irrigation of 400 acres of land within the described place of use.**


