State of Oregon, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground (Well)
Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is Seven second-feet.
One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.
(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and domestic
Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.


