State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public
waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorpora-

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Las Vegas Artesian Basin

This facility is designated as Well No. 8, which with well No. 9 proposed to be drilled, which with well No. 10, which proof of completion of work has been submitted, which with Wells No. 1, 2, 3, 4, 6 and 7 and which proof of beneficial use has been submitted, constitutes Nellis Air Force Base Water Supply.

Since the filing of permit serial No. 17522 on April 3, 1958 and approved on 12 November 1958, for 0.60 C.F.S. of water, it has been determined that an increase of an additional 0.76 C.F.S. more of water from this well is required.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights and is further subject to revocation when water is available from the Las Vegas Valley Water District, and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 0.76 c.f.s. A meter must be installed in the discharge pipe line, near the point of diversion, and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030; therefore, the State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.76 cubic feet per second

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 8, 1961

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 8, 1961

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 8, 1962

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 8, 1962

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 8, 1963

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before July 8, 1963
