

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant C. P. BREEDLOVE, JR. of 700 Harvard, Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an underground source. Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 2.0 second-feet. One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet. acre-feet.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic Use. Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) 160

(b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered)

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 11. Remarks")

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: in NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section 12, T. 12 S., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M., and at a point from which the North 1/4 Cor. of said section 12 bears N. 81°33'55" E., a Distance of 340.19 ft.

6. Place of use NW 1/4 of NW 1/4, NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section 12, T. 12 S., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M., and SE 1/4 of SW 1/4, NE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Section 1, T. 12 S., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M.

7. Use will begin about Jan. 1 and end about Dec. 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Water will be diverted by a drilled Well and distributed by a system consisting of a pump, storage tank, ditches and pipe lines.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 2.0 c.f.s. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept, and a method provided, either air line or opening, for measuring depth to water. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second, or a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 19, 1961
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before December 19, 1961
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 19, 1962
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 19, 1962
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 19, 1964
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 19, 1964
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 19, 1964
