APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 5.4 c.f.s. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept, and a method provided, either air line or opening, for measuring depth to water. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 5.4 cubic feet per second, or a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 11, 1962
 Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before August 11, 1962
 Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 11, 1963
 Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 11, 1963
 Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 11, 1966
 Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before August 11, 1966
 Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before August 11, 1966
