The applicant The City of Carson City, a municipal corporation of the State of Nevada
of Carson City, County of Ormsby,

State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) The City of Carson City was chartered in 1875.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground source in Ormsby County

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.10 second-feet.

872 feet from the West quarter corner of said section 15.

6. Place of use NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 15 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Well, 8" diameter by 120 feet deep, 5 HP Hollowshaft Peerless Pump, 370 gallon pressure and storage tank. All piping to boilers, hose bibs, fixtures, sumps, etc.
State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

11. Remarks.....Water is used for washing down chains, grates, skimmer
sweeps and troughs, sumps and tanks; for float control adjustment;
for breaking scum in digester, laboratory work, shower and toilet,
boiler, irrigation of shrubs and lawns, tank haulage for compaction
and dust control, etc. In addition, this well will serve any future
developments by the City in this portion of the parcel.....

.....APPROVAL..... OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 0.10 c.f.s. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept, and a method provided, either air line or opening, for measuring depth to water. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second.
