The applicant DESERT ROSE MOTEL

State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin)

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.05 CFS or 1.3 MG annually second-feet

3. The water to be used for Commercial (Motel) & Domestic  
Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. Place of use SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 and the N 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of sec. 20, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M.

7. Use will begin about January 1st. and end about December 31st. of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Water is developed by means of a drilled 12" well and is pumped through a distribution system to a 27 unit motel within the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 and the N 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of sec. 20, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B & M.  
State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

9. Estimated cost of works..... Built and in use.
10. Estimated time required to construct works..... In use.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to existing rights and is further subject to revocation if and when water can be furnished by an entity such as a water district or a municipality engaged in furnishing water and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 0.02 c.f.s. A meter must be installed in the discharge pipe line, near the point of diversion, and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and an air line for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030; therefore, the State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second, not to exceed 2.5 mg annually.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 3, 1964
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 3, 1964
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 3, 1965
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 3, 1965
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 3, 1966
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 3, 1966
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before.....
