TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Edw. H. and James M. Smiley

State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) Edw. H. and James M. Smiley

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground

2. The amount of water applied for is One second-foot

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 13,
T. 37 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the accented
south one quarter corner of said section 13 bears S. 88° E., 506.00 feet

6. Place of use SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of section 13 and NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 24 all in
T. 37 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drilled well, pump. Water is pumped by windmill into 4,000 gal. underground concrete tank. (Overflow is returned to well) Then piped to a 400 gal. stock watering tank with automatic float shut off valve.

10. Estimated time required to construct works.....One year

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to alleexisting rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of cattle served from the waters of this source. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0125 cubic feet per second or sufficient water to water 400 cattle and horses.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before.....December 26, 1963

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before.....January 26, 1964

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before.....December 26, 1964

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before.....January 26, 1965

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before.....December 26, 1965

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before.....January 26, 1966
