TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicantS Herman M. Adams and Durrell M. Adams of 300 Fremont St. Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) Herman M. Adams and Durrell M. Adams.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Basin. Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 5.00 second-feet. One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic. Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) 200

(b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered)

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 11. Remarks")

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 14 S., R. 69 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears N. 64° 15' E 3470 ft. from the West 1/4 Cor. of Sec. 33. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of a public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. Place of use SE 1/4 SW 1/4, and SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 20; NW 1/4 NW 1/4, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SW 1/4 NW 1/4, and SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 33; and SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 32, all in T. 14 S., R. 69 E., M.D.B. & M. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about February 1st and end about Dec. 31st, of each year. Month Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Pump with 8" discharge pipe, 230 ft. of 14" and 310 ft. of 10" casing in well; 1/2 mile of main ditch and 1/2 mile of laterals. Chrysler 350 HP, stationary engine. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

9. Estimated cost of works \$14,000.00
10. Estimated time required to construct works 30 days
11. Remarks Former attempts to farm this area by diverting water from the Virgin River proved unsuccessful because of the fine soil carried by the river flow. By pumping, this problem of suspended fines will be eliminated.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 3.4 c.f.s. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and an air line for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.4 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a seasonal duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 25, 1964
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before December 25, 1964
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 25, 1965
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 25, 1965
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 25, 1968
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 25, 1968
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 25, 1968
