

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Frank Carl Denker of Box 3, Rim Forest, County of San Bernardino, State of California, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 2.7 c.f.s. second-foot One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) 160

(b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered)

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 11. Remarks")

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 19 S.,

R. 52 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 26 bears S. 46° 04' E., 3,449.95 feet. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. Place of use SE 1/4 Section 26, T. 19 S., R. 52 E., M.D.B. & M. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year. Month Month
