TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Maida P. Bradley, % Lund Stage of Lund, County of White Pine, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground. Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 5.4 c.f.s. second-foot. One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic. Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) 320 acres

(b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered)

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 11. Remarks")

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: In the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 30, T. 13N., R. 62E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the Northwest corner of said Section 30 bears N. 87° 34' W., 2309 feet distant. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. Place of use W 1/2 W 1/2 (Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4) NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 30, T. 13N., R. 62E., M.D.B. & M., and the E 1/2 SE 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 25, T. 13N., R. 61E., M.D.B. & M. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year. Month Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) It is proposed to drill, case and develop an irrigation well at the location described above and equip it for irrigation of a Desert Land Entry described under Paragraph 6 above. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

9. Estimated cost of works in \$12,000.00

10. Estimated time required to construct works 3 years

11. Remarks: This well will be used in conjunction with a Desert Land Entry Application filed with the Bureau of Land Management.
