The applicant Blaine Sharp and Lewis Sharp of Arthur Route, Wells, County of Elko

State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Sharp Spring No. 2 Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.007 second-foot One second-foot equals 448.83-gals. per min.
