The applicant International Community Development Corporation of Nevada

State of Nevada 89112, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public

waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) A Nevada Corporation, established in Las Vegas, Nevada, in November 1971, Mr. Donald Melius, President.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is effluent discharge channel, Clark County Sanitation District.
