TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant United States of America, Forest Service of Ogden, County of Weber, State of Utah

hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is East Union Canyon Spring Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is .0015 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

3. The water to be used for Stockwatering Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: At spring which is 12,793.7'

S72° 57' W from the corner of Section 8, 9, 16, 17; T12N, R40E, MDB&M being within Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 13, T12N, R39E, MDB&M of unsurveyed land. it should be stated.

6. Place of use Same as 5 Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about May 1 and end about December 1, of each year. Month Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Water is piped from spring box to trough through 83 feet of 2" gal. pipe. The trough is equipped with an overflow State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

9. Estimated cost of works ..... \$100.00

10. Estimated time required to construct works ..... 6 months

11. Remarks ..... This is for a stockwatering development located on the Toiyabe National Forest.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of cattle served from the waters of this source. It is further understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The Well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and an air line for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0015 cubic feet per second of sufficient water to water 50 head of cattle.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 20, 1965

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before March 20, 1965

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 20, 1966

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 20, 1966

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 20, 1967

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 20, 1967
