- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Jackson Creek
2. The amount of water applied for is 6.0 second-feet
3. The water to be used for Mining, Milling and Domestic
4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation, (b) Stockwater, (c) Other use, (d) Power
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 29, T. 40 N., R. 32 E., M.D.B. & M.
6. Place of use: Portion SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 29 and portion SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 30, Township 40 North, Range 32 East, M.D.B. & M.
7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st
8. Description of proposed works: construct small earth dam to divert water to pipe line to plant storage tank.
