State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) Date of incorporation

July 10, 1957, in State of Nevada

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed ditch flowing through SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 23, T. 17 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M., Washoe Valley, Nevada

2. The amount of water applied for is one-third of flow of ditch, 0.25 second-foot One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for irrigation Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) 21 acres

(b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered)

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: a point within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4

Section 23, T. 17 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M., from which the common 1/4 corner Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land,

Section 23-26 bears S 54° 15' E a distance of 940.0' it should be stated.

6. Place of use Portion of SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 23, T. 17 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.
