Point of diversion of a portion

of water heretofore appropriated under application 19228

1. The source of water is underground source - Pahrump Valley Basin (Name of stream, lake or other source.)

2. The amount of water to be changed 2.0 (Second feet, acre feet.)

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and domestic (If for stock state number and kind of animals.)

4. The water heretofore used for Irrigation and domestic (If for stock state number and kind of animals.)

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 21 South, Range 53 East, M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the Northwest corner of said Section 14 bears North 86° 25' West a distance of 1,224.0 feet.

6. The existing point of diversion is located within the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 21 South, Range 53 East, M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the North Quarter corner of said Section 14 bears North 71° 43' East a distance of 316.0 feet.

7. Proposed place of use the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4; the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4; the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4; the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4; the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4; and the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4; all in Section 14, Township 21 South, Range 53 East, M.D.B. & M. containing 240 acres.

8. Existing place of use the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4; the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4; the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4; the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4; the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4; and the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4; all in Section 14, Township 21 South, Range 53 East, M.D.B. & M. Containing 240 acres.

9. Use will be from January 1st to December 31st of each year.

10. Use has been from January 1st to December 31st of each year.

11. Description of proposed works.

Well 14 inch casing, pump, 1 1/2 miles supply ditch, 1/2 mile metal pipe.
