State of Arizona, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source and is limited to what the well will produce but not to exceed 4.98 c.f.s. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and an air line for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 4.98 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 10, 1965  
 Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before September 10, 1965  
 Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 10, 1966  
 Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 10, 1966  
 Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 10, 1968  
 Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 10, 1968  
 Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 10, 1968
