The applicant Dewey Dann of Beowawe, County of Eureka, State of Nevada, hereby make s application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Hand Me Down Creek Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is Six (6) second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year. Month Month
