The applicant Donald G. Trenary of Box 324, Lathrop Wells, County of Nye

State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 4.0 second-foot One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

6. Place of use SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 18; N 1/4 NE 1/4, SE 1/4 NE 1/4, E 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 19, T. 17 S., R. 50 E. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.
