

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Francis Taylor of Moapa, County of Clark

State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Source, Clark County, Nevada. Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 1.0 c.f.s. second-foot One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) 43 acres.

(b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered)

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 11. Remarks")

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 23, T. 14 S., R. 65 E., M.D.B. & M., County of Clark, State of Nevada, or at a point Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, from which the northwest corner of said Section 23 bears North 48°29' it should be stated. 23" West a distance of 882.85 feet.

6. Place of use NE 1/4 NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Portion of the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 NW 1/4, and the N 1/2 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 all in Section 23, T. 14 S., R. 65 E. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Month Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) 14" well 100 feet deep together with various pipes which will transport the water to the place of use. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

9. Estimated cost of works \$10,000.00

10. Estimated time required to construct works Well is in existence.

11. Remarks This well replaces the well which was drilled under Well Permit #12458 (Cancelled January 9, 1956) which had collapsed.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and an air line for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 11, 1967

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 11, 1967

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 11, 1968

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 11, 1968

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 11, 1969

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 11, 1969

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 11, 1969

Commencement of work filed DEC 9, 1968

Completion of work filed DEC 9, 1968

Proof of beneficial use filed DEC 4, 1975

Cultural map filed JAN 12, 1976
