The applicant State of Nevada, by Nevada State Prison of Carson City, County of Ormsby

State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground source in Ormsby County Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 2.0 second-foot One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and domestic Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) 1,186 acres

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 11. Remarks")

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: A point in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 4, T. 14 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., from which the NW corner of said Section 4 bears N. 13° 53' W., 4330 feet. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

Place of use In Sec. 3: SW 1/4 SW 1/4; In Sec. 4: S 1/2 SE 1/4, W 1/2 NE 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4; E 1/2 W 1/2; Portions of NW 1/4 NW 1/4 (36A), SW 1/4 NW 1/4 (26A), NW 1/4 SW 1/4 (22A), SW 1/4 SW 1/4 (31A); In Sec. 8: Portions of SE 1/4 SE 1/4 (21A), NE 1/4 SE 1/4 (11A); In Sec. 9: NE 1/4, E 1/2 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Portion of NW 1/4 NW 1/4 (39A), SW 1/4 W 1/2 SE 1/4; In Sec. 10: W 1/2 NW 1/4; all in T. 14 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year. Month Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Existing Farm Well to be rehabilitated water to be conveyed north to irrigated areas through pipe system. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

9. Estimated cost of works..... \$30,000

10. Estimated time required to construct works..... 8 months

11. Remarks Well log for original farm well was submitted to State Engineer July 9, 1930. According to best information heavy irrigation use was made of this well for many years; however no water right application was filed. Water from the rehabilitated well will be used for domestic purposes in farm area and will be piped north to Minimum Security Prison area for irrigation and for emergency fire protection and emergency domestic use there.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and an air line for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 23, 1967

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 23, 1967

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 23, 1968

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 23, 1968

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 23, 1971

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before June 23, 1971

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before June 23, 1971

Commencement of work filed Dec 2, 1967

Completion of work filed Dec 2, 1967

Proof of beneficial use filed FEB 12 1973
