The applicant Philip J. Carter of Lund, County of White Pine, Nevada

State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground. Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 4.0 c.f.s. second-feet. One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation & domestic. Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

acre plat in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 18 T.12 N., R.62 E., or at a point

Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land,

from which the NE corner of said Sec. 18 bears N. 10°35'37" E. 4226.92 feet distant. it should be stated.

6. Place of use Lot 4 Block 11A; Lot 1 & 4 Block 12A; Lot 4 Block 13A;

Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

Lot 1 & 4 Block 14A and Lot 1 Block 15A, Lund 10 acre plat which are a portion of SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 18 and the E 1/2 Sec. 19, T.12 N., R.62 E., M.D.B&M.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year. Month Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) It is proposed to drill

develop and case a 16" well and equip with turbine pump and electric motor. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and an air line for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.7 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 3.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 22, 1968
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 22, 1968
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 22, 1969
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 22, 1969
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 22, 1971
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before June 22, 1971
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before June 22, 1971
