of water heretofore appropriated under Muddy Valley Irrigation Company Water Shares (70 Shares) (one) 1/2 Second Foot from the St. Thomas Site to the Source at the Warm Springs Site. Proof 01627. Certificate 266, a portion thereof.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of the waters of the Muddy River as heretofore appropriated under Certificate 266 as appears in the Muddy River Decree as entered on March 12, 1920 in the Tenth Judicial District Court, State of Nevada, County of Clark. The permit is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected. A totalizing and momentary meter must be installed and maintained in the pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The meter must be installed within 90 days of the issuance of this permit.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 723.80 ac. ft. annually.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 3, 1972

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 3, 1972

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 3, 1972

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 3, 1972

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 3, 1975

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 3, 1975
