TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Robert H. Ruud of P. O. Box 138, Pahrump, County of Nye

State of Nevada, hereby makes application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 2.7 second-foot One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

T. 20 S., R. 53 E., M.D.M., Nevada from which the NE Cor., of said Sec. 9 bears N 53° 12' 00" E., a distance of 61.5 feet. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. Place of use wholly within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 4, T. 20 S., R. 53 E., M.D.M., and the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 20 S., R. 53 E., M.D.M. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year. Month Month
