APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 21926 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 21926 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening, an air line and a weir or other type of measuring device at or near the well to facilitate the measurement and control of the water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.4 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 7, 1967

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before April 7, 1967

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 7, 1968

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before April 7, 1968

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before March 7, 1971

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 7, 1971

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 7, 1971

Commencement of work filed May 7, 1967

Completion of work filed MAY 7, 1969
