TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Index-Daley Mines Company of Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake

State of Utah, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) November 17, 1952; Boise, Idaho

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 3.00 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

R. 64E., M.D.B. & M. at a point from which the SW Cor. said Sec. 18

Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, bears S. 18° 39' 44" W., 2677.05 feet distant. it should be stated.

6. Place of use in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 18, T. 31N., R. 64E., M.D.B. & M. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year. Month Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) continued underground mining activity has developed adequate water to justify serious consideration of placing said developed water to beneficial use in furtherance of mining, milling and domestic use by Index-Daley Mines Co. Water will be diverted from the mouth of the tunnel and impounded for company use.

9. Estimated cost of works \$3,000.00
10. Estimated time required to construct works 3 years
11. Remarks The Index-Daley Mines Co., under its long range development plan cannot be obligated to deliver any fixed or constant flow of developed water to a natural channel for perpetuating other water uses on this source of supply.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and an air line for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 17, 1967
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 17, 1967
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 17, 1968
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 17, 1968
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 17, 1970
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before June 17, 1970
