

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant THE A. REVERT TRUST, by ARTHUR E. REVERT of BEATTY, County of NYE,

State of NEVADA, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is THE REVERT SPRINGS, also sometimes known as and called THE BEATTY SPRINGS

2. The amount of water applied for is 4 CFS, LESS that already owned by applicant

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) Approximately 400 acres

(b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered) 100 head of horses and cattle

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 11. Remarks") SEE REMARKS

(d) Power:

(2) Point of return of water to stream NONE

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: A point within the SE 1/4

SW 1/4, Section 5, T 12S, R 47E, MDB&M which bears S 63° - 28' - 30" W

A distance of 2550 feet from the SW Corner of said Section 5.

6. Place of use ALL IN STATE OF NEVADA, COUNTY OF NYE, as follows

T12S, R 47E: Sec 5, SE 1/4 NE 1/4; NE 1/4 NE 1/4; SW 1/4; Sec 7:

Part of NE 1/4; Sec 8, NW 1/4 NW 1/4; Sec 4; NW 1/4 NW 1/4; T11S, R 47 E;

Sec 33: SW 1/4 NW 1/4

7. Use will begin about January and end about December, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) THE MAJORITY OF THE LAND MAY BE

IRRIGATED BY A GRAVITY FLOW FROM THE SPRING. THE INSTALLATION OF A PUMP WILL BE NECESSARY TO REACH A PORTION OF THE LAND.
