The applicant James C. Sweger and Don S. York of Reno, County of Washoe, State of Nevada

hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) James C. Sweger and Don S. York

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground waters Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 2.50 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Recreational (irrigation of golf course, approximately 150 acres) and domestic Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) 150 acres

(b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered)

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 11. Remarks")

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: 1/4 NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Sec. 9, T. 21N., R. 18E., M.D.B.&M. at a point from which the South 1/4 corner of said Sec. 9 bears S. 15°49'14" W., 2971.75 feet distant Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. Place of use: E 1/2 of Sec. 23; W 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 24; NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 26; T. 21N., R. 18E., M.D.B.&M. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about Jan. 1st and end about Dec. 31st, of each year. Month Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) It is proposed to drill Well No. 2 and case and install necessary works for recreational and irrigation of golf course and other related uses, including pipe line and distribution system. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

9. Estimated cost of works \$1000,000 (includes pump, pipe line and distribution system existing Well No. 1, and Wells No. 2 and No. 3.)
10. Estimated time required to construct works 3 years
11. Remarks It is proposed to drill Well No. 2 and install all necessary works for recreational and domestic use related to golf course

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. The total combined diversion under Permits 23169, 23172 and 23173 shall not exceed 1 million gallons per day.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.5 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 1, 1970
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before March 1, 1970
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 1, 1971
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 1, 1971
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 1, 1973
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 1, 1973
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 1, 1973
