The applicant Charley H. Smith of Montgomery Pass Via Benton, Calif., County of Mineral State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Queen's Canyon Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 2.0 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet 175 acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Irrigation & Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. If use is for:

Or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 25 bears S. 88° 33' E., 2,619 Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.
