APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. A substantial headgate and measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. This permit is further issued subject to the terms and conditions stipulated under Ruling 1042.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of lands irrigated from any and/or all sources.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 24, 1969
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before March 24, 1969
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 24, 1970
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 24, 1970
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 24, 1971
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 24, 1971
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 24, 1971
