The applicant Onetha Mines, Inc. a Nevada corporation with principal offices at 226 Atlas Building, Salt Lake City, Utah 84101, and Nevada offices at 1333 Avenue "G", East Ely, County of White Pine, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. 11. Remarks The Onetha Mine is the only mine at Hamilton, White Pine Mining District consistently mining for the past 15 years and the only mine now in operation. Water for culinary and mining use has been taken from this spring for at least the past 8 years. We know of no other beneficial use of water from this spring other than for livestock during the summer months. There has been no prior objection to this use. The continued use of water is necessary to maintain our camp and mining operations currently employing 7 men.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby ~~grant~~ ^{deny} the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:


