

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Glenn W. Lane Springs of 10770 Painter Ave., Santa Fe, County of Los Angeles State of California, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is 2.70 c.f.s. second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-feet

3. The water to be used for irrigation Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

6. Place of use. Portions of the following SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 1, E 1/4 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

Lots 1, 2, 7 & 8 of Block 14 A of the Preston Ten Acre Plat Survey

Sec. 12, Lots 2 & 3 of Block 2 of the Preston Five Acre Plat Survey

Sec. 13, T. 12 N., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M. and SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Lots 1, 6, 7,

& 8 Block 8 of the Preston One and One Quarter Acre Plat Survey

Sec. 7, T. 12 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year. Month Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) It is proposed to drill, develop, case and equip an irrigation well at the location shown on the supporting map.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and an air line for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed immediately and a record of the periods of time the pump is running as well as the measurements of water used must be kept by the permittee and forwarded monthly to the Division of Water Resources. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and

not to exceed 2.7 cubic feet per second but not to exceed a yearly duty of 3.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 24, 1968
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before June 24, 1968
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before May 24, 1969
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before June 24, 1969
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before May 24, 1971
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before June 24, 1971
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before June 24, 1971
