The applicant W. Dalton La Rue, Sr., and Juanita S. La Rue dba Winnemucca Ranch of 522 California Avenue, Reno, County of Washoe, State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

(If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Dry or Matley Creek Name of stream, lake or other source.

2. The amount of water applied for is second-foot One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min. (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet: 400 acre-foot

3. The water to be used for storage for irrigation (R.H.) Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use.

4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) 86.3 (b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered) (c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 11. Remarks") (d) Power: (1) Horsepower developed (2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 30, T.25N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 30 bears S. 4° 59' 33" W., 1,199 feet, Washoe County, Nevada. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. Place of use (See attached sheet) Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about Jan. 1 (R.H.) and end about Dec. 31 (R.H.), of each year. Month Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) By using the same dams and ditches in Application Nos. 11827, 13677, and 17830, Certificate Nos. 4966, 4967, and 5021 respectively. 9. Estimated cost of works \$1,000.00

10. Estimated time required to construct works 2 weeks.

11. Remarks Applicants are the owners of Application Nos. 11827, 13677, and 17830 with Certificate Nos. 4966, 4967, and 5021. This is for an additional appropriation of 400 acre-feet of water to be stored in existing facilities known as Spanish Springs Reservoir and to be used through existing ditch and regulating reservoirs for use on 86.3 acres in Section 18 and 19, T.24N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit to store 400 acre-feet of water between January 1st and December 31st, for irrigation on 86.3 acres of land is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. The proof of beneficial use and cultural map when filed, must show the maximum amount of water stored and released during any one year, and the lands on which such water was used. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed _____ cubic feet per second but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 3, 1968

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before November 3, 1968

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 3, 1969

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 3, 1969

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 3, 1971

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 3, 1971

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 3, 1971

Commencement of work filed SEP 16, 1968

Completion of work filed NOV 28, 1969

Proof of beneficial use filed SEP 22, 1970
