

APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Nevada Fish and Game Commission of Box 10678, Reno, County of Washoe

State of Nevada 89510, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground Name of stream, lake or other source

2. The amount of water applied for is 10.0 second-foot One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-foot

3. The water to be used for irrigation Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) 120

(b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered)

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 36

T. 17 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M. from which point the SE corner of said Sec. 36 Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, lies N. 89° 48' 45" E. 40.45 feet it should be stated.

6. Place of use portions of E 1/2 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 1, T. 16 N., R. 19 E., SE 1/4 NE 1/4, E 1/2 SE 1/4 Sec. 36, T. 17 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M. Describe by legal subdivision, if on unsurveyed land it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Month Month

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) A high capacity deep well will be drilled and fitted with a turbine pump. Concrete lined ditches will distribute the water. State manner in which water is to be diverted, whether by dam or other works, whether through pipes, ditches, flumes, or other conduits.

- 9. Estimated cost of works \$25,000
- 10. Estimated time required to construct works five years
- 11. Remarks Crops irrigated with this water will be harvested by waterfowl therefore creating unusual irrigation seasons. A sprinkler system may be utilized.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and an air line for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. No perforations shall be put in the casing less than 100 feet from the ground surface unless the log shows a satisfactory confining formation nearer the ground surface. The total combined amount of water granted under this Permit and Permit 24004 is limited to what the well covered under the two Permits is capable of producing. If Certificates of Appropriation are issued under this Permit and Permit 24004, the total combined amount of appropriation granted in said Certificates shall not exceed what the well covered under the two Permits is capable of producing.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.4 cubic feet per second but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or sources.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 19, 1968
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before September 19, 1968
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 19, 1969
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 19, 1969
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 19, 1971
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 19, 1971
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 19, 1971
