The applicant Moapa Valley Water Co. and Overton Water District  
of Logandale and Overton, County of Clark,

State of Nevada, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground source - Moapa Valley,

Place of use: All of Sections 14, 15, 16, the E $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 21, all of Sections 22, 23, 26, 27, 28, 34 and 35 in Township 15 South, Range 67 East, M.D.B.&M. all of Sections 1, 2, 3, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 24 and 25 in Township 16 South, Range 67 E., M.D.B.&M., all of Sections 7, 18, 19, 20, 30 and 31 in Township 16 South Range 68 East, M.D.B.&M.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and an air line for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. The total combined amount of water granted under this Permit and Permit 23872 is limited to what the well covered under the two Permits is capable of producing. If Certificates of Appropriation are issued under this Permit and Permit 23872, the total combined amount of appropriation granted in said Certificates shall not exceed what the well covered under the two Permits is capable of producing.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 6.0 cubic feet per second but not to exceed a yearly duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 19, 1968
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before September 19, 1968
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 19, 1969
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 19, 1969
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 19, 1972
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 19, 1972
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 19, 1972
