The applicant David A. Witts, 1000 Vaughn Building of Dallas, County of Dallas

State of Texas, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground source (North Dutch John, Well No. 2)

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.0156 c.f.s. second-foot

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet acre-foot

3. The water to be used for stockwatering

4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation (state number of acres to be irrigated) (b) Stockwater (state number and kinds of animals to be watered) 500 head of cattle (c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 11. Remarks") (d) Power: (1) Horsepower developed (2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 7 N., R. 65 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 6, T. 7 N., R. 66 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 67° 17' E., 11,086.05 feet distant.

6. Place of use: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 11, T. 7 N., R. 65 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) It is proposed to drill, case and equip a stockwatering well.

9. Estimated cost of works: \$5,000.00

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of cattle served from the waters of this source. It is further understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and an air line for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0156 cubic feet per second or sufficient water to water 500 head of cattle.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 14, 1968

Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before July 14, 1968

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 14, 1969

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before July 14, 1969

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before June 14, 1970

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before July 14, 1970
