The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: within the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 7, Township 21 South, Range 54 East, M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the East Quarter corner of Section 12, Township 21 South, Range 53 East, M.D.B.&M. bears South 76 14' 00" west a distance of 2477.06 feet.

6. Place of use within all of the West Half (W 1/2) of Section 7, Township 21 South, Range 54 East, M.D.B.&M.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) well, pump, casing approximately 2 1/2 miles of supply pipe or ditch.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening, and an air line and a parshall flume. The location of the latter to be approved by the State Engineer. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030; therefore, the State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.5 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

- Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 2, 1968
- Proof of commencement of work shall be filed before September 2, 1968
- Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 2, 1969
- Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 2, 1969
- Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 2, 1972
- Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 2, 1972
- Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 2, 1972
